About the Survey and its Objective

The feedback survey was designed to assess the curriculum's significance and applicability as well as its progress in meeting the demands of the learning environment. Several curriculum topics that are very important to students are covered in the structured questionnaire. The survey inquires about the following: the usefulness of the college's educational materials; the effectiveness of the internal evaluation procedure; the relevance of the course material, including the importance of industry visits; and the degree to which the course material encourages creativity and results in the discovery of novel concepts and ideas.

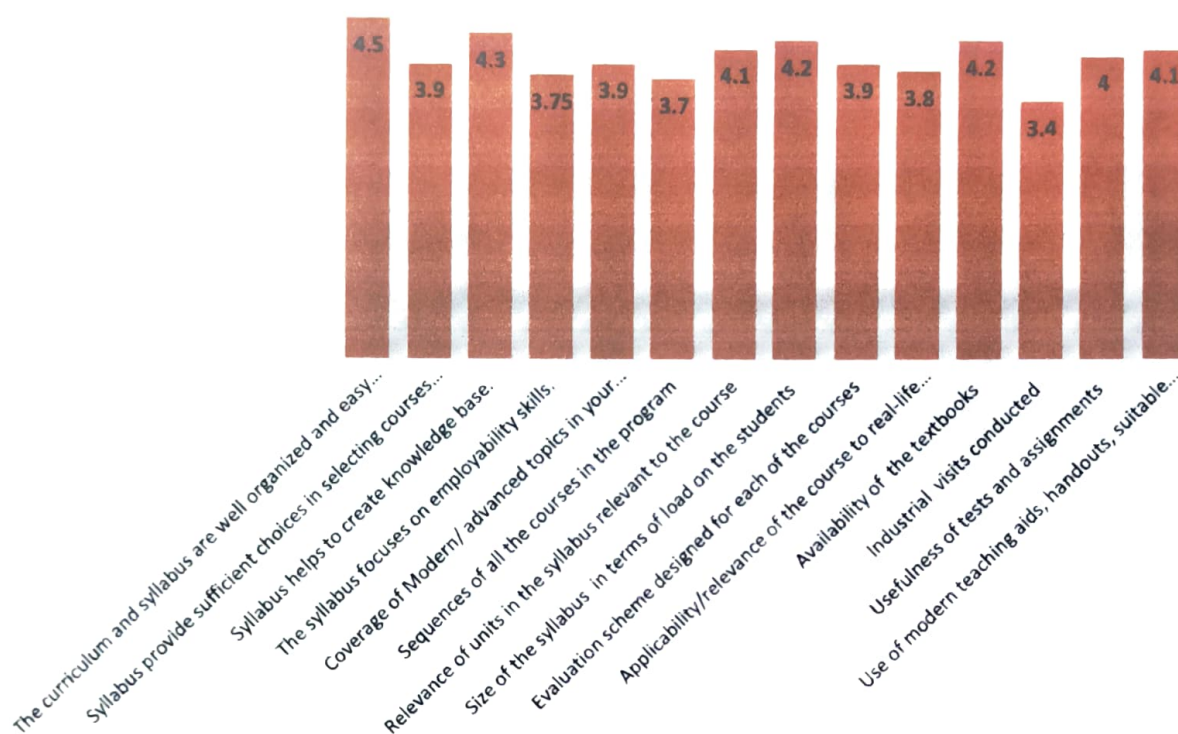

Interpretation

The overall average for the fourteen statements evaluated for the 2022–2023 student feedback was close to 4 out of 5. The organization of curriculum and syllabus received the highest mean score of 4.5, followed by the helpfulness of the syllabus to create a knowledge base with a mean score of 4.3. A mean score of 4.1 was attributed to the use of modern teaching aids, handouts, suitable references, Powerpoint presentations, online resources, etc. The lowest mean score was attributed to the industrial visits conducted.



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
