The college was founded in 1964 by His Grace Mathews Mar Coorilos, the Bishop of Kollam Diocese who later became His Holiness Moran Mar Baselios Marthoma Mathews II, the Catholicos of the East. The founding of the college was the successful realization of a long cherished dream. His Grace Mathews Mar Coorilos who always desired to increase and expand the educational facilities within the diocese, worked tirelessly in that direction surmounting various difficulties. The foundation stone of the college was laid by His Grace Thomas Mar Dionysius the then Metropolitan of Niranam Diocese at 10am on Monday, 22 June 1964 and the college was declared open on Monday, 6 July 1964 by Late Lamented His Holiness Moran Mar Baselios Ougen I the erstwhile Catholicos.

National Service Scheme

The NSS unit of the institution is a vibrant and highly motivated body. Students have attended numerous camps in and outside Kerala and conducted various educational and social extension programmes at local, district and state levels. Select initiatives by the National Service Scheme unit of the college are listed below:

1. **Vimukthi**: an anti-narcotics campaign launched by the Government of Kerala aimed at eradicating narcotic substances from society. The unit participated in the campaign by launching a series of programmes under the title **Bodhapournami**. Awareness classes, rallies, competitions like debates, quiz competitions, flash mobs, exhibitions, street play, friendly football match etc. were organized throughout the academic year. An Anti-drug Sena called **Asaad Sena** was formulated with 20 volunteers on 23 March 2023.
2. **Palliative Care**: a students' unit for palliative care runs parallel with NSS annual activities in collaboration with Taluk Hospital Kottarakara. The unit conducts activities like palliative care field work with trained volunteers, blood donations, medicine distribution, financial charitable support, awareness programmes, etc.
3. **Blood donation** camps and the maintenance of a Blood Donation Directory, a record of all the volunteers' blood group details

Health awareness programmes, environmental and social work, charity, visits to special care homes, women and child empowerment and gender sensitization events, surveys, road safety awareness campaigns, day commemorations and disaster management classes were organized in the year.

4. Medical equipment donation: Medicines and medical equipment like water bed and colostomy bags were given to Thaluk Hospital, Kottarakara on December 15, 2022.
5. A medical camp was conducted on November 19, 2022 by NSS, the Palliative care unit and medical council, Kottarakara municipality at Vimalambika School Kottarakara. Homeo, Ayurveda and Sidha Streams of medical care were given through the camp
6. Onam kit distribution: September 2, 2022. Kits were also distributed to Street vendors as well as college cleaning staff
7. Cloth donation for palliative care patients: December 25,2022 called Kuppayakudu in collaboration with Karuthal Group and Bappuji Vayanasala Perumkulam
8. Adopted village: A renovation programme was conducted at the anganavadi KR15 in the adopted village of the NSS unit Gurumuttam. The project was named as SWAPNAKODU. The renovated Anganavadi was inaugurated on January 11, 2023.

In addition to these, various awareness raising rallies, campaigns and flash mobs were organized by the NSS, NCC, and departments for the welfare and empowerment of the general public.



Environmental Awareness

1. On 5 June 2022, the NSS organized the planting of trees at the college campus. Under the joint participation of NCC unit 9(K) Bn NCC and the Forest Department, an innovative approach of providing biodegradable seed beds as an alternative to plastic was introduced. Cadets of the NCC unit participated in the distribution and planting of saplings. The Zoology Association and Nature club organized the planting of saplings in the Butterfly Garden and a seminar presentation by Ms. Prameela Shaji to enlighten the importance of observing World Environment Day.
2. On 16 July 2022, the NCC unit organized a Meenpidippara Cleaning Drive during which plastic and other waste materials were removed by cadets from the water of Meenpidipara, a nearby tourist spot.
3. The Zoology department organized a Nature Camp at Shenthuruny, Wildlife Sanctuary on 04 – 09- 2022.
4. As part of the Swachh Amrita Mahotsava campaign, a rally was held by the NSS unit on 17 September 2022 from the College Junction to Meenpidippara for spreading awareness about river conservation. After the rally volunteers and other people worked alongside to clean the river and its surroundings.
5. In October 2022, as part of Swachhata Hi Seva, the NCC unit participated in the cleaning and planting of saplings at college, nearby areas, the roadside etc.
6. The NSS Unit of St. Gregorios College Kottarakara conducted an online program on ozone day at 7 pm on 16 October 2022, session taken by Ms. Fathima.S (Second year NSS Volunteer).
7. On 13-12-2022, the Women's Study Unit in collaboration with the college IQAC and the Haritha Keralam Mission organized a hands-on training session on making eco-friendly paper pens.
8. The Forestry Club conducted a field visit on Jan 13, 2023 to Malamel area of Kollam district, which is an ecologically sensitive area.
9. The NSS unit organized a three-day Nature camp at Idukki from March 9, 2023.
10. The Department of Zoology celebrated international forestry day on March 21, 2023. To observe the importance of that day students had staged a skit 'Maram oru varam'. The Forestry club conducted awareness class, tree planting in the college and saplings were gifted to each department. A short film named *The Elephant Whisperers* was screened at the college digital theater.

Constitutional and Humanitarian Values

1. Students of the department of English arranged an anti-drug awareness flash mob on the college campus on the anti-drugs day, 29 June 2022.



2. In association with the District Panchayat's Citizen Awareness Programme, the Department of Political Science organized an awareness session on Article 14. The session was handled by Ms Sreelakshmi Jayan, Head of the Department.
3. The Department of Oriental Languages organized two programmes in connection with the 75th Independence Day Celebration:
 - i. On 11/08/2022, an awareness class on "Patriotism" was organized for first-year BCom Students.
 - ii. Essay and painting competitions were conducted for the first year BA/ BSc students on 12/08/2022. The theme was "My Perspective on Independent India".
4. To make the student community aware about cyber crimes and the misuse of social media, an awareness session on the topic 'Cyber Laws use of Social Media' was organized by the NSS unit on 11 November 2022. The session was taken by Adv. G. K. Sreejith.

6.
