About the Survey and its Objective

The feedback survey was created to evaluate the curriculum's significance and applicability, as well as its progress toward meeting the expectations of the learning environment. The organized questionnaire covers a number of curriculum subjects that students find extremely significant. The survey asks about the following: the usefulness of the college's educational materials; the effectiveness of the internal evaluation procedure; the relevance of the course material, including the significance of industry visits; and the degree to which the course material encourages creativity and leads to the discovery of novel concepts and ideas.



Interpretation

The overall average for the fourteen statements evaluated for the 2023–2024 student feedback was close to 4 out of 5. The organization of curriculum and syllabus received the highest mean score of 4.40. A mean score of 4.3 was attributed to the use of modern teaching aids, handouts, suitable references, Powerpoint presentations, online resources, etc. The helpfulness of the syllabus to create a knowledge base and relevance of units in the syllabus stood third with a mean score of 4.25. The lowest mean score (3.25) was attributed to the
